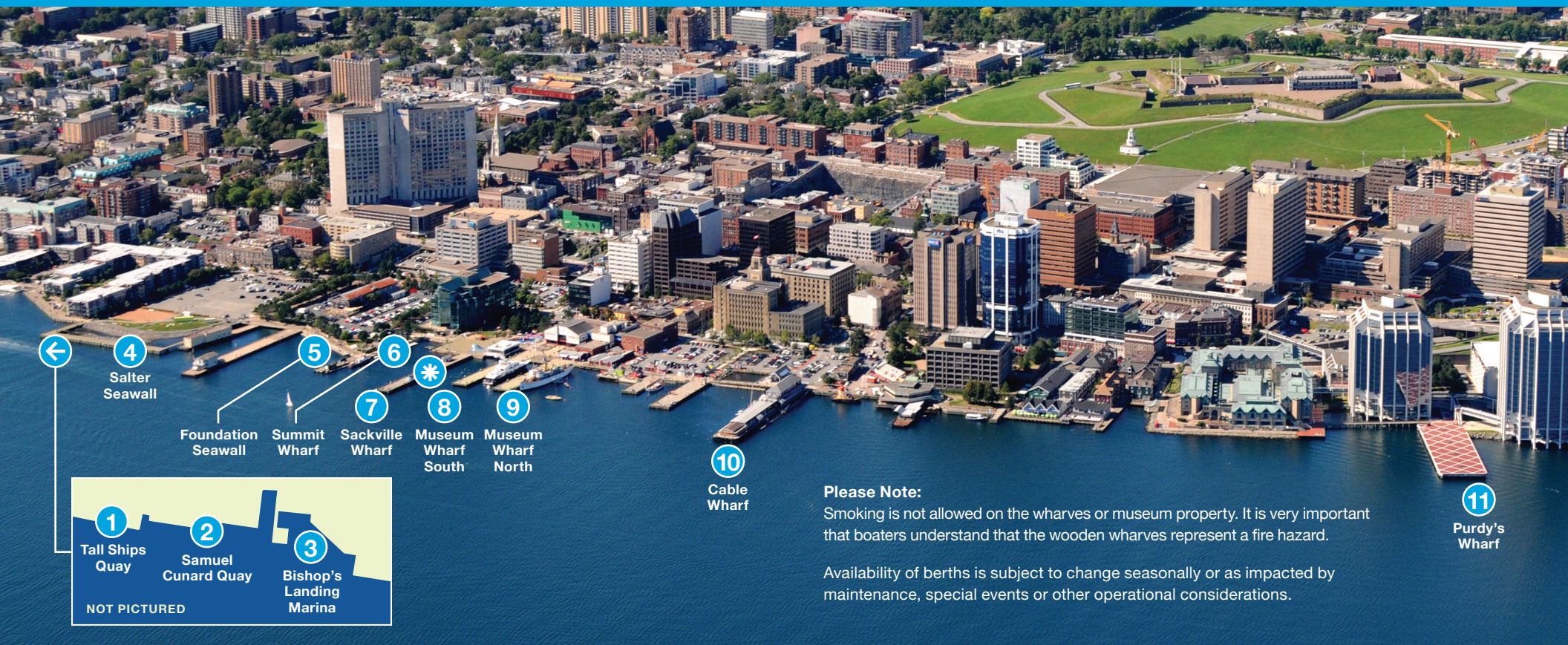

3 BISHOP'S LANDING MARINA

- Daily and overnight dockage on 387 ft. (118 m) of floating dock
- Shore power and water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

4 SALTER SEAWALL

- Daily and overnight dockage on 426 ft. (130 m) of seawall
- Shore power and water available

5 FOUNDATION SEAWALL

- Daily and overnight docking on 210 ft. (64 m) of floating dock
- Shore power and water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

6 SUMMIT WHARF

- Daily and overnight docking on 120 ft. (36 m) of floating dock
- Water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

7 SACKVILLE WHARF

- Daily and overnight docking on 180 ft. (54 m) of floating dock
- Shore power and water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

8 MUSEUM WHARF SOUTH

- Daily and overnight docking on over 300 ft. (91 m) of floating dock
- Shore power and water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

9 MUSEUM WHARF NORTH

- Daily and overnight docking on 180 ft. (54 m) of seawall

10 CABLE WHARF

- Daily and overnight docking on 270 ft. (82 m) of floating dock
- Shore power and water available
- Garbage receptacles (sorted garbage only)

11 PURDY'S WHARF

- Daily and overnight docking on 120 ft. (36 m) of floating dock
